NEW CONTRACT AWARD!

Caladwich is adding seven full-time personnel to its Naval Construction Group ONE (NCG-1) support team at Port Hueneme, California. Making this our 3rd contract at NCG-1, this expansion reinforces our role in providing day-to-day logistics, full spectrum warehouse management, inventory control, and equipment accountability for the Navy's Seabees, ensuring smooth operations for both deployed and homeport Naval Mobile Construction Battalions (NMCBs). Our new team is responsible for managing the Civil Engineer Support Equipment (CESE) program, which includes nearly 2,400 vehicles and heavy equipment assets. We also oversee a massive inventory of over 400,000 non-CESE Table of Allowance (TOA) line items and 250,000 Aircraft Repair Parts (ARP) line items, coordinating 40,000+ warehouse transactions each year. This includes receiving, inspecting, storing, and issuing parts and equipment, as well as coordinating shipments and excessing outdated materials.
